



MRG Guide to Non-Malignant Surgical Lesions in the Breast

High Risk Lesions (surgical consultation recommended)

1. Atypical ductal hyperplasia (ADH)
2. Flat epithelial atypia (FEA)
3. Lobular neoplasia - lobular carcinoma in situ (LCIS) and atypical lobular hyperplasia (ALH)
4. Atypical papilloma
5. Radial scar/complex sclerosing lesion (unless microscopic and incidental to the targeted lesion)
6. Bland papilloma (unless microscopic and incidental to the targeted lesion)
7. Mucocele-like lesion (or if core biopsy shows extravasated stromal mucin)

Locally Aggressive Lesions (likely to require surgical consultation for local excision)

1. Phyllodes tumor
2. Fibromatosis
3. Granular cell tumor

Please note... **PASH** does not usually require surgical consultation. Surgical referral can be reserved for cases that have a prior diagnosis and an enlarging area or other concerning clinical changes.
