

Dr. Hopkin's Limited Intravenous Pyelogram (IPV) Protocol:

- Pt greeted by X-Ray tech and taken to CT.
- CT tech to hand inject 75cc of Contrast after standard check for allergies and renal function etc.
- X-ray tech to take patient back to the X-ray and perform 1 KUB film centered from the top of the kidneys to the bottom of the pelvis. Film should be taken between 7-10 mins after injection.
- Show film to radiologist.
- If both ureters seen to the bladder and non-dilated, complete exam and dictate. If needed, one additional film exposed at ~20 mins after injection.

Routine: 1 view

- AP. Centered from the top of the kidneys to the bottom of the pelvis.
