



Gastrografin Challenge

Supplies:

- 1 Gastrografin
- 1 Saline Syringe (if applicable due to NG/OG tube)

ALL images are to be labeled with proper markers (scout, laterality, minutes, etc...)

Scout:

KUB

Procedure:

1. Patient is Supine. Take KUB (Label Scout). This is to verify that there is no residual contrast that would interfere with study.
 - If patient has NG/OG, verify placement prior to giving Gastrografin to patient.
 - Pt is to have NO Suction.
2. Send image to PACS.
3. PACS note must contain information:
 - Amount of contrast given (90 ml of Gastrografin)
 - Lot/expiration numbers
 - Time contrast was given to patient
4. KUB taken **8 hours** after Gastrografin has been consumed (Label image).
5. PACS note completed with any additional information.
